KINGSCLERE Parish Council Burial Authority Fees from 1st January 2024

- 1) For the purposes of this table of fees, the term "Resident" is a person who meets the following criteria, **immediately before their death** (KPC reserve the right to review individual circumstances on a case-by-case basis):
 - Was an inhabitant in the Parish of Kingsclere

Paid council tax in the Parish of Kingsclere for a continuous period of at least 5 years immediately before death (other earlier periods of residency could result in Non-Resident Fees being applied, if KPC grant permission)

Note: In the case of a child, then the above resident criteria will apply to either of the parents.

- 2) Non-Residents are not able to purchase Exclusive Rights prior to death. All non-resident applications may only be completed at the sole discretion of the Parish Council.
- 3) Kingsclere Parish Council undertakes Memorial Safety Checks in line with National Safety Standards and charges may be incurred where memorials fail safety checks. The Parish Council reserve the right to lay down, secure, or remove any memorials for deemed unsafe.
- 4) Fees for grave digging are not included in the costs detailed here they are charged and arranged by your Funeral Director.
- 5) All burials in the Ecchinswell Road Cemetery must be arranged through a Funeral Director.
- 6) Full Rules and Regulations are on the website and will require signed agreement.
- 7) Payment should be received from the Funeral Director Prior to burial taking place

Note to Funeral Directors: All surplus stone / rubble must be removed completely away from the burial ground immediately after the grave has been filled in. The surface of the burial plot must be left flat and not raised; except for a small amount to allow for sinkage. (see Rules and Regulations)
